CONNECTED YOUTH INITIATIVE (CYI) WAIVER OF CONSENT FORM

In certain circumstances minors 18 years old or younger, such as yourself, are allowed to waive their parent or guardian's right to consent, which is normally required for release of a minor's personal information. The following are examples of reasons that a person 18 years old or younger (minor) may allow for waiver of consent:

- Minor is outside of parental influence or control
- Minor lives independently from parent or guardian
- Parental or guardian interests do not reflect the child's interests due to family environment issues (e.g., neglect or abuse)

If you are 18 years old or younger and unable to obtain parent or guardian consent due to any example described above, you may waive parental consent by signing below. By signing this form, you agree to waive your parent or guardian's right to consent to release your information due to lack of contact or another reason as described above. This consent starts on the date you sign this form and this will expire after five (5) years from the date of signature.
