Behavioral Health for Youth provides specific programs designed to educate youth on the harmful effects of alcohol and drugs, giving them the knowledge and skills to avoid substance abuse.

Ceremonies and Sweats recognizes the importance of incorporating the traditional methods of healing into the lives of Native Americans.

Diabetes Programs for registered tribal members will receive glucose testing supplies, diabetes education classes, nutrition consultations, Nurse Foot care clinic, cooking classes and more.

Ponca Hills Health & Wellness Center includes dental services, medical services and pharmacy services.

Purchased/Referred Care funds are intended to assist Tribal members in payment of healthcare when no other sources are available or to supplement other sources available or to supplement other alternate resources in the event they have been exhausted.

The Public Health Department is to protect, promote, and advance the health and safety of Native communities in the PTN Service Delivery Areas.

Community Health Representatives serve as liaisons between the healthcare provider and client. Providing outreach, health education and promotion and disease prevention to the Native communities residing in the PTN Service Delivery Areas.

Northern Ponca Housing Authority is the tribally designated housing entity for the Ponca Tribe of Nebraska.
